OUR 23/24 REGISTRATION NUMBERS!

Members want to know ... How has registration gone this year? *The answer* ... **VERY WELL!**

Our investment in our promotional mailer certainly paid off resulting in 20 NEW Youth Members and 33 NEW Adult Curling Members. Nine of these new members participated in our Learn to Curl 'Try First' Program. The League with the highest growth is our Thursday Evening Mixed that now has two full draws with one bye team (17 teams total)! It is nice to see some younger couples out for date night.

An interesting stat to highlight is that 2/3 rd's of our Adult Members have joined us in the last three years! Of course

not ALL of these NEW Members were brand new curlers, but it does speak to the fact that the majority of our membership are relatively new to our sport. Our numbers have certainly grown since our pre-COVID 19/20 season when TOTAL Membership was 80.

<u>HELP KEEP OUR ICE CLEAN & IN GREAT SHAPE!</u>

All returning members should have noticed our new 'Sticky Mats' that we are now using at the entry to our rink. We can all play a part in helping to keep our ice clean and free of debris. Please brush and or wash your broom head often and consider replacing it on a yearly basis. Similarly grippers can start to wear and 'pill' with small pieces breaking off. This debris can cause rocks to 'pick' on the ice affecting rock movement. Consider changing your grippers annually as well. You can now purchase replacement heads and grippers at our bar.

In addition, we would like to enforce where 'street shoes' are worn in our facility. Many of you are aware that in other curling clubs street shoes are to be removed at the door. In the weeks ahead you will see new signage indicating that street shoes are to be worn only from our entrance downstairs into the locker area. Street shoes are to be left in your locker or under benches where you will change into your curling shoes. Your curling shoes are then worn up the stairs on the washroom/bar side and into the lounge. The lounge will be for curling shoes OR clean footwear that you bring into the club to wear. If you wish to change out of your curing shoes after playing consider bringing a pair of clean shoes that you can wear in lounge. When you leave you can return to your locker via bar side stair well, change into your street shoes and exit by the entrance stairwell.

Smokers are asked to leave their boots/shoes at the door so that no externally worn street shoes are worn up the stair into the lounge. We thank everyone in advance for your cooperation.
