WHAT IS A LOONIE AUCTION? HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Our Auctioneer (Jack Little!) holds up an item and invites you to bid.
- If you want to bid hold up your hand and index finger. The Auctioneer will point at you and assign you a number. YOU are responsible for writing the number assigned on the paper provided AND tossing your loonie in the basket on the table.
- You can bid as often as you like on the item ... at each bid you are assigned another number - that you write down ... AND toss another loonie into the basket.
- When there are no more bids we use a computer to randomly pick a number between '1' and the 'maximum bid' number. The winning number is displayed on the TV screen by the bar.
- IF you win you jump up and down and come and claim your prize! If you don't have the number you clap for the person who won, cross out the numbers you wrote down and continue to bid on other items!
- We also have a section where you buy tickets, place your ticket in the item bag, winners are drawn and winning numbers posted.

A FEW TIPS:

- Things can go quickly and we want to keep the evening moving ... so make sure you make eye contact and know what number you are assigned!
- IF you really want the item you can make multiple bids at once! Instead of
 just your index finger hold up two fingers (two #'s) or your entire hand (5
 #"s) and our Auctioneer can assign you a number for each finger. Hold up
 both hands with all 10 fingers and you will get 10 numbers!
- It can get exciting DON'T forget to put your Loonies in the basket and please remind your table mates to do so as well!


