BCC RE-OPENING MON JAN 31ST III

We are pleased to advise that your BOD's have decided to re-open our facility as soon as we are able to do so. The recent announcement from the Provincial government allows sporting facilities to open at 50% capacity effective Monday January 31st. We have also decided to remain cautious and open under COVID play rules AND with the bar closed. We will reassess those conditions during our second week of opening and determine if they are still warranted. Trust us when we say our priority is keeping our membership safe and healthy and our facility open. We do not want to risk having club transmissions in numbers that may require another closure. The Beaverton Curling Club has been fortunate so far this season as we have not had to close due to transmissions, while many other clubs have. We have all of you to thank for that ... for staying home when showing any signs of COVID ... for isolating after exposure ... for getting your booster shots ... and in general showing concern for your fellow members and community. *Let's keep that up and CURL!*

You will notice the 50% capacity guidelines mean there are capacity limit signs for our change rooms and washrooms. We now must also 'actively' screen everyone who enters the facility rather than passively asking you to sign that you acknowledge all of the screening conditions. This may take a bit longer upon entry and the sign in log has been moved to the immediate foyer. Please be patient with us and consider arriving 30min prior to play as it may take a little longer. You can remove your mask on the ice during game play but otherwise it is to be on at all times when in the facility and off of the ice. Please respect the social distancing guidelines. With the change in government guidelines for PCR testing and the fact they are no longer involved with contact tracing the onus is now on us. Even though we have it we must also ask for your phone number. We have updated our COVID PLAN and it will be on our website by Jan 31st.
